- Your Grad Nite Ticket grants you access to Disney California Adventure® From 1pm-2am
- Private GN party begins at 9:00pm in Disney California Adventure® Park until 2:00am
- Bus loading for the return trip will be from 2:00am-2:30am
- Bus departs from Disneyland at 2:30am
- Buses will arrive back to ECHS parking lot by 3am

Students must be transported to and from Disney California Adventure by bus. No private cars are allowed. No Disneyland Passes are allowed. Students must not leave Disney California Adventure at any time. You must be appropriately dressed. No alcohol, drugs or smoking allowed. Students must be in good standing and abide by graduation rules in order to participate. ECHS reserves the right to decline permission to attend.
